School Photos

St Johns Park Public School will be supporting 'Stomp Out the Gap' on Thursday 7th June, 2018.



By getting involved in this important event our school is helping us to stomp out the education gap for Indigenous children across Australia. 100% of money raised on the day will go directly into delivering the Cathy Freeman Foundation's life-changing education programs.

Last year our school was amongst 650 other schools around Australia that participated in the inaugural 'Stomp Out The Gap' campaign, raising over \$58,000.

Our support last year inspired by so many amazing stories of young Indigenous people succeeding at school and going on to achieve their dreams.

For example:

- Almost 50% more Year 12 students graduated across the four Cathy Freeman Foundation partner communities compared to 2016.
- Every Year 12 graduate had been on a Cathy Freeman Foundation personal development and aspirational camp called Horizons during their school
- By joining Stomp Out the Gap 2018, our students can learn more about Indigenous culture whilst raising funds for life-changing education programs for Indigenous kids.

Peer Support

Focus: Moving Forward – Resilience

Week 4

This week in Peer Support children will have an opportunity to discuss their personal qualities and strengths. The children will identify their qualities and acknowledge how they contribute to their achievements. Through activities, children recognise they used their strengths to achieve success and can be encouraged to approach future activities optimistically.

Ask your child to describe their own qualities and strengths so you can recognise and acknowledge these.

Week 5

This week in Peer Support children will discuss skills and how to communicate their feelings and needs to others. The children will discuss skills they use when participating in a variety of activities. When children understand they already have many of the skills needed to succeed, they can feel more confident when trying something new. The children are asked to identify events which trigger different feelings.

Encourage your child to remember the skills they have used in one activity when trying something new. Also, encourage your child to communicate their feelings and needs.

St Johns Park Acknowledgement and Merit System

Whole school and classroom Acknowledgement System.

1. Students receive tokens below to collect on their class token chart.



2. When a student has received 5 tokens across, they receive a PB4L Token Draw ticket for the Stage Assembly ticket draw.



3. When a student receives 30 tokens (a full token chart) they will receive a 30 tokens certificate. At the completion of each token chart a student will receive a certificate at the next level.

1 full PB4L chart = 30 tokens certificate
 2nd full PB4L chart = 60 tokens certificate
 3rd full PB4L chart = 90 tokens certificate

1. All major awards (shown bellow) count toward Gold and Silver Awards.
 Any combination of these 4 awards result in a Silver Award.

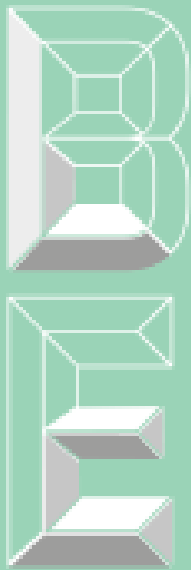
