Term 4 Roadmap

The note asks whether your child is remaining at our school or whether your child is moving to another school. We ask that these notes are returned as soon as possible. Kindergarten 2022 Applications

Healthy Lunch Box Recipes

Healthy Lunch Box recipe

Japanese vegetable pancakes



Ingredients

½ small cabbage, very thinly sliced
4 medium carrots, grated
2 cups baby spinach, very thinly sliced
4 spring onions, thinly sliced
½ cup wholemeal plain flour
6 large eggs, lightly beaten
Pinch of salt
Olive oil spray

Method

Place the vegetables in a bowl and mix together. Toss with the flour, ensuring it coats all the vegetables. Stir in the eggs and pinch of salt.

Lightly spray a large non-stick fry pan with olive oil spray and heat over medium-high heat. You may need to re-spray between batches.

Add heaped tablespoons of the mixture to the fry pan in rounds. Gently press to flatten. Cook until golden, approximately 3 minutes, and then turn to cook the other side.

Healthy Lunch Box recipe

Super crispy chicken fingers



Ingredients

1½ cups panko breadcrumbs
Olive oil spray
1 egg
2 tbsp reduced-fat milk
1 tbsp mayonnaise
1½ tsp Dijon mustard
2 tbsp plain flour
500g chicken tenderloins
Salt & pepper

Method

Preheat oven to 200°C. Spread breadcrumbs onto a baking tray. Spray carefully with oil and bake for 3 to 5 minutes until light golden. Transfer to a bowl.

In a medium bowl, add the egg, milk, mayonnaise, mustard, flour and a little salt and pepper. Whisk with a fork until well combined. Add a chicken tender to the batter and toss to coat. Toss in the breadcrumbs and press gently into the chicken. Place on a lined baking tray. Repeat with remaining chicken.

Spray carefully with oil and bake for 10-15 minutes or until cooked through and golden brown.

Serve with a fresh garden salad.
